Omnilux Revive was developed as a non-surgical light therapy to help combat visible signs of ageing, plumping visible fine lines and wrinkles and maximising the benefits of skincare products.

Omnilux Revive is neither a laser nor an IPL treatment — it’s a non-invasive photofacial for sun-damaged or ageing skin. “It uses only the red-light part of the natural white light spectrum,” says Mandy Gray, Marketing Director, Doctors Formula, “and the treatment is painless — it’s usually paired with a professional salon facial for maximum results.” It may also be used as an adjunct to laser, IPL, microdermabrasion and other cosmetic treatments.

THE PROCEDURE This light therapy reaches areas of the skin that your therapist’s hands simply can’t reach. “It’s similar to how photosynthesis works in plants,” explains Gray. “It works by complementing the body’s own natural ability to refresh the skin, renew moisture, and working to plump up skin naturally.”

Clients usually feel a pleasant, warm feeling under the light beam, as the light head surrounds the face with thousands of light-emitting diodes radiating pure red light. “It is much like lying on the beach in the sun for 20 minutes, without the harmful UVA, UVB or infrared radiation,” says Gray. The clinician can shape the light to the contour of a specific area, for more targeted treatments.

THE TIMING The first treatment takes 45 minutes, while ongoing treatments are typically 30-minute appointments, which include 20 minutes of light therapy. No recovery time is needed. A typical course is usually three to nine treatments, depending on the extent of fine lines, wrinkles and uneven skin tone. After the course, maintenance treatments every four to six weeks help to prolong the results.

THE RESULTS Many clients experience an immediate effect, says Gray: “Your skin usually looks clearer, brighter and smoother after the first treatment.” Naturally, every client is different — the length of the course, and the client’s individual skin type and texture will determine the overall results on fine lines and wrinkles, she says. “I personally try to get under it as much as possible. It can only positively benefit my skin.”

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
